- I. <u>CALL TO ORDER</u> Chairman Barnhart called the meeting to order at 9:00 AM and led the Pledge of Allegiance.
- II. <u>WELCOME AND INTRODUCTIONS</u>—Chairman Barnhart welcomed those present. Meetings attendees introduced themselves.
- III. <u>APPROVAL OF AGENDA</u> The agenda was approved as presented.
- IV. STANDING AGENDA

V. <u>BOARD CHAIR REPORT</u> - There was no report.

VI. DIRECTOR'S REPORT

Director Fosse reported on the following items:

- 1. <u>General Items</u> There were no general items reported.
 - A. A recent quarterly generator test was conducted and the auxiliary power failed to start; one of the batteries was completely dead and the other battery was weak. This was the first time in RiverCom's history that this has happened. RiverCom is re-evaluating the system and addressing the issue as well as other emergency-mode procedures. The Board requested that RiverCom conduct a study and bring back a report to the Board on any changes made.

2. Radio Site Report

- A. Day Wireless Systems is currently working on the roof for the structure at the Lower Badger radio site. The project continues to move forward; RiverCom anticipates an April 1 final completion date.
- B. A Request for Proposals (RFP) was issued on December 5, 2014 for radio engineering and consulting services for Phase 4 radio coverage enhancements. The due date for proposals is January 23, 2015. A mandatory pre-proposal conference is scheduled for next week. The RFP was reviewed by legal counsel prior to issuance.
- C. Board Member Snyder asked about the status of the boundary issue at Lower Badger. Director Fosse reported that Steve Crossland sent a letter to the neighboring property owners but they claimed not to have received the communication. Crossland is in the process of resending the letter.

3. Staffing Report

A. There were three (3) individuals in the Training Academy for Emergency Services Dispatcher positions; however, one of those individuals has resigned from employment to take a position with Wenatchee Police Department.

4. State E911 Office Report

- A. Director Fosse provided the Board with a copy of a communication issued by the State of Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission, dated December 2, 2014. The communication addresses the statewide 911 outage that took place in April 2014.
- B. The State E911 Office has been restructured and as a result, Ziggy Dahl is no longer the head of Homeland security but will now be more focused on the Washington State 911 system.
- C. RiverCom continues to work with Telecommunications Systems to establish a final contract and schedule the installation of the new phone system. TCS has indicated that the earliest they can install is April 21, 2015, and that if that date cannot be assured that the work would take place in mid-June. If the work is not completed in this timeframe,

RiverCom could lose state funding of the new system which would expose RiverCom to the full cost of the system.

- The Board thanked Kent Sisson for serving on the Board as the representative from the operations group for the year 2014.
- Mick Lamar, Chief at Chelan County Fire District No. 4 and No. 9, will serve as the voting Board member representing the operations group for the year 2015.

XIV. EXECUTIVE SESSION

A. At 9:45 AM, Chairman Barnhart entertained a motion to move into Executive Session for the purpose of discussing a RIVERCOM Guild grievance issue, the period of time not to exceed fifteen (15) minutes, with action to be taken afterward.

Motion to move into Executive Session; Snyder, second by Kuntz. Resolution: Motion Carried.

The Executive Session ended at 9:54 AM and the regular meeting was immediately called back to order.

Motion to accept prepared letter regarding Step 2 Grievance Hearing outlining the Board determination and response to Grievance 1 and Grievance 2 filed by the RiverCom Dispatchers Guild, and to authorize Keith Goehner and Kent Sisson to sign said letter; Kuntz, second by Snyder. Resolution: Motion carried.

XV. <u>ADJOURNMENT</u> - With no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 9:55 AM. The next Board session is scheduled for January 14, 2015.
